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1 Opening of Meeting

CP proposes to include also the Chairs of the Committees. DG and others do not want to increase further the number of attendees.





3 Clinical Journal

The Editorial Team (LC) has been in contact with the Psychosozial-Verlag (PsV) regarding the next Clinical Journal (2021 – 31). Options of how to continue has been discussed. VH (as treasurer) has gone through the different options for next year:

- 1. Continue to publish the Clinical Journal in paper
- 2. Change to electronic book (temporary decision)
- 3. Change to electronic book (long run decision)
- 4. Look for another publisher house ("low cost")
- 5. Self-publishing and use of free of charge apps and platforms (like slideshare)

The BoT members endorse or strongly agree on

Option 2: Change to electronic book (temporary decision).

The e-book of 2021 will be considered as a test run and the BoT will assess it later (in 2020/2021) for making a long-time decision.

The IIBA will include the Directors and Presidents of the affiliated local societies and active members (survey, poll, feedback) in the decision process regarding the future of the Clinical Journal.

Costs of option 2: 5200 EUR (net) for the issue of 2021 (English).

Services included:

- The PsV will continue to support the Editorial Team.
- The PsV will set up and maintain an individual website for the Clinical Journal.
- The PsV will produce a PDF and an HTML version of all articles and the whole Clinical Journal on the basis of a word file provided by the Editorial Team.
- The Clinical Journal will be available for everybody for free as a HTML and a PDF version under a creative commons license.
- All articles and the issues will be attributed with doi-numbers. (Advantage: The e-journal will be listed in several databases. The PsV will take care of exporting all the necessary meta-data for that.
- The PsV will offer a printed version for sale (on demand). People, who are interested in obtaining a printed copy can order such a copy at their own expense via the website of





PsV. LC (and VH) will discuss special price for IIBA members and she will find out the shipping costs.

The e-book will also enhance the visibility of the IIBA and of the Clinical Journal in the internet and in the academic field (as the access to the Clinical Journal is free, it can also be easily integrated in catalogues of libraries).

LC (and VH) will inform the Editorial Team and PsV about the decisions made.

4 Webinars

Due to lack of time, this topic is not discussed further.

PM (Teaching Committee) sent a short summary of the situation prior to the virtual BoT meeting:

- The Teaching Committee is collecting experience and best practices information about online teaching.
- 4 International Faculty Members and 1 Emeritus International Faculty have shown interest in training via IIBA Webinars.

The Teaching Committee will present a roadmap for establishing and conducting webinars.

5 26th IIBA International Conference

The Organizing and Scientific Committee has already started to organize the 26th IIBA International Conference: virtual and in-person.

6 Social Media: Speaking Bioenergetics
