"The Unexpected Guest: Shame and Body." We had the pleasure to have Janina Fisher, from the Trauma Centre (founded by Bessel van der Kolk), in Oakland, California, USA, as our keynote guest

We had 280 participants who were present at the event. We were so delighted that Janina noticed the great involvement of young members in the program. She mentioned that it is very difficult in the Trauma Center to have a generational change of this kind. This has made us very proud because all this is the result of the effort that SIAB has been doing in this direction in recent years

Our intent was to 1) to consolidate relationships with other similar approaches on subjects that are of interest to us, especially with authors dealing with the trauma. As well as 2) to show our members, even the youngest, who trustfully look at other approaches, that indeed our tradition is so rich that we have nothing new to "learn"!

The next SIAB conference in 2019 will be in Fiuggi (a place near Rome) on the subject "Back to Basics. The treasure of BA techniques from a relational perspective".

It will sure represent an opportunity to have a deep dialogue on our clinical work and on the body techniques that both represent our legacy.

To the person who suffers shame, the world is full of eyes, crowded with things and people that cam see. Bewitching eyes watch every moment and moment of self. The core Of agony in shame is this element of exposure. One is visible and not ready to be seen, looking and not ready to see. There is a constant, excruciating feeling in shame of being looked at while hoping the ground beneath your feet will open and swallow you up. (Mary Y. Ayers, Ph.D.)

Shame resides in the dark recesses of our psyches. It restricts the flow of energy in our bodies and deadens the spirit. Shame inhibits us from contact with others. Rage makes active our inner helplessness and shame. Expressing rage moves energy out, freeing, temporarily, built up tension. Rage feels powerful and protects us from feeling the shame within. However, the cycle of shame and rage will again be put into process if the underlying shame is not acknowledged and addressed.

The PDW is an unique occasion for all participants to practice and to learn more as they are supervised in their clinical work, to share with colleagues from many different places, to attend theoretical presentations and to be supported and helped in their professional development in a safe, secure and empathetic atmosphere.
